

My doctor's office said, "we don't take this insurance." WHAT DO I DO?

1. Refer them to the ClaimDOC number on the front of your insurance card: 888.330.7295

Why: ClaimDOC functions as the network replacement for HMR's health plan. They will be able to tell your doctor that the plan will pay them for services. If your doctor is asking about what network you have, just have them call ClaimDOC! You can call ClaimDOC before your appointment and they will reach out for you!!

2. If you doctor needs to verify eligibility and/benefits (i.e. copay, deductible, etc.) refer them to the phone number for benefits verification on the back of your card: 800-967-2077

Why: Your doctor's office will often want/need to verify that you are in fact covered by HMR's health plan. Edison Health Solutions is our TPA (third party administrator) and they can help your provider through that process. Their number is also on the front of your card at the very top: 888-47EDISON (888 47334766).
